

Search in Files

Summary:

This application takes the windows search utility to another step. It will allow searching for files containing multiple keywords and phrases. It will search starting from the “Search Path” (set up in the configuration) and move down all subdirectories (subfolders). When the results are displayed, either double click on the item to open or select multiple items and chose File – Open Selected from the menu.

Files:

SearchInFiles.exe - The stand-alone executable
SearchInFiles.ini - The configuration file

Installation:

Save the two files above into the desired folder. If the executable is renamed, the configuration file must be renamed or a new one will be created when configured.


Configuration:

From the main window select File – Configure to display the configuration window.

Enter the Application Title. This title is the window title.

Enter the Search Path which is the starting path for the search.

Enter the File Name to find. Wild cards are acceptable.



Usage:

Enter a key word or phrase at the Find containing prompt and if any additional key word or phrases can be entered at the two and prompts below.

Click on the Search button to start the search. It may take a while since it does search contents of files. The search is done as an ASCII search.
