

## Instructions

What you are going to extract;

1. MaxxHi5RT VST plugin
2. MaxxHi5RT (Folder)

Extract the VST plug-in and the folder called; MaxxHi5RT to your VST folder where (your VST plug-ins are on your computer) .

3. Make a .wav file called > tmp

4. Put this file > "tmp.wav" into the folder MaxxHi5RT.

The folder MaxxHi5RT is where your recordings will be from using the VST MaxxHi5RT, your recordings name is tmp.wav in this folder MaxxHi5RT.

Make sure that the "tmp.wav" file is;

Stereo or mono

-----

16 bit [bits per sample]

44100 [Frequency]

### How to use it

When loaded this VST start's to record (note that the VST starts recording right a way once you have loaded it in your VST host) just play form computer keyboard keys from other VST instrument(s), to stop the recording unload/disconnect/remove the MaxxHi5RT VST.

#Your recording is in the folder MaxxHi5RT (in your VST folder you will find this folder) with the file name of "tmp.wav" now you can copy this file "tmp.wav" to your music work projects and rename it too, once copied here.
